

NGE, INC. Installer's Policy

Welcome to the easiest installation of any Mat Hoist® unit on the market

1. Installers must possess liability insurance for a minimum of \$500,000.00
 - 1a. Current policy must be on file each year at NGE, Inc. home office prior to installation.
2. Installers receive precise step-by-step instructions for each Mat Hoist® model, and are expected to utilize such. These instructions have been created from personal installation experiences of the manufacturer himself and staff.
 - 2a. It is recognized that a unique building design may require some minor adaptations on site.
3. Installers are not personally expected to run electrical power from the building source to the Mat Hoist® motor unless certified. The unit is pre-wired and tested at the factory. The unit can be elevated from the floor by its own power. To do so, you will need to have temporary three phase 12 gauge wire for lifting the unit in the gym and setting limit switches. It is strongly RECOMMENDED to coordinate the electrical wiring of the unit from the building's source at the time of your installation.
4. It is the installer's sole responsibility for properly securing the unit, demonstrating the unit to the customer and completing the customer demonstration form. You are to forward this completed document to NGE, Inc.
 - 4a. It is the installer's final responsibility to assure that the unit is operating properly whether with permanent or temporary three phase electrical power.
5. Damage to the Mat Hoist® from installation, from improperly wiring or improperly setting of the limit switches could void NGE, Inc. warranties.
